- Eligibility for awards

- Financial Travis Olivera
 - Report submitted
 - Vote to approve budget. M. Barlett motion to approve and 2nd by M. Hedeen. Passes unanimously
 - Travis has emailed our accountant

 - Everything from the USA Racing order should be in by the SOS packet pickup
- o Equipment and Rental Phil Trzcinski
 - Trailer will be moving back to the Parkway in early April (likely week before SOS)
 - Weights on the tent updates cost is about \$1/pound for weight, for each tent about \$200 to secure, also would need \$200 to secure arch
 - Suggested that we should try and have equipment to secure 2 tents and one arch
 - Motion by T. Olivera 2nd by M. Hedeen to secure weights for 3 tents and 1 arch, maximum amount approved \$1,000. Passes unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Additional Youth XC Program
 - Grant application was submitted to the Community Foundation on February 29th, hopefully will hear back from them
 - Idea is that is would start at the Dev Run and then continue, plan to provide T-shirts, snacks, some shoes
 - Request for \$5,000 for the program
- Continued discussion about racing team
 - If you are running a race and you want to captain it and get people to run with you is the direction for racing team
 - Chris Edick willing to take on one event
 - Andrew Rubino may be interested in captaining Peak to Brew
 - If there are any other runners who want to do the event we would be interested in doing that
 - Meant to help recognize more of our speedy runners to help support them
 - o Goal is also to increase camaraderie
 - Other potential race options: Old Forge for peoples first marathon or half marathon
 - Need to determine rewards: reimbursements, snacks, gas reimbursement
 - Or see if race will allow a group discount for the race team
 - Maybe reimburse the captain's race fees (at a limit) and then provide snacks and gas money
 - Anyone else to reach out to about this initiative? Maybe look at list from Grand Prix or past races and start asking
