## Donation to the City of Utica

The Southwoods Switchbacks are an important part of Utica Roadrunners history that has grown to be identified with the Club, particularly with the Falling Leaves, Save Our Switchbacks race, and Development Runs. In the Spring of 1996, the 2-mile South Woods trail became a safety hazard due to an extremely severe winter. Due to the efforts of Ted Petrillo and other Utica Roadrunners, the City was able to temporarily repair the most damaged sections, reopen the trail, and begin a long term plan to preserve the South Woods trail. In 2017, George Searles and David Jones coordinated the project that installed the fitness stations.

## Meet Andy Hartnett



Meet board member Andy Hartnett. He's our social media director, overseeing the club website and related efforts, a role that's consistent with his longtime career as a software architect with NYCM Insurance, a position he snagged after completing his computer science degree at SUNY Poly.

Andy joined the board shortly after becoming a Roadrunner a couple of years ago. He ran for fun in high school, but since then has become more serious about it, completing more than a dozen Boilermakers (PR 1:17:54) and many other competitions: all three of the 2023 Peak to Brew sprints, and 22 races this year alone, including the Peak to Brew, the Brookfield Classic 15K, and the Falling Leaves 14K. We should note that Andy finished in fifth place overall at the Race the Lake Marathon in Cooperstown last June.

Having already logged more than the required 1,000 miles, he'll receive his well-earned red jacket at the awards ceremony next spring. "Anyone can run. It doesn't matter your time or pace; just doing it is what counts," Andy told SpliTimes.

Originally from Oswego, he now lives in Sauquoit with his wife and teenaged twins.

From what I heard, this was one of the best pickups we've had in recent history.

The Kid's Kilometer kicked off the races with over 170 runners finishing. It's always fun seeing the future runners of the Mohawk Valley get a love for running and community spirit early on. The Leatherstocking Council BSA New Hartford Pack 14 was on site with ax throwing for kids of all ages!

Next was the opening ceremony with Melissa Barlett flawlessly performing the national anthem. Assemblywoman Marianne Buttenschon presented a Legislative Resolution recognizing the outstanding work of the Utica Roadrunners organization. Thank you Assemblywoman for attending. The Dick Mattia Award was presented to Mike Brych for his long standing dedication as a volunteer and continued promotion of running. Mike directed the Falling Leaves for 15 years, has been the voice of the Falling Leaves for almost a decade, organizes the New Hartford men and women's cross-country teams at the water stations, and continues to work behind the scenes to ensure the starting line is locked down race day. Thank you Lauren Mattia for taking the lead on the awards committee this year.

The 5k and 14k went off promptly at 9am. 582 runners completed the 5k and 321 runners completed the 14k. This year HISTORY WAS MADE with the first ever 5k female overall finisher Katie Phillips taking it all with a gun time of 18:50! The second place finisher of the 5k and first place male finisher was Dean Geesler with a gun time of 19:07. The first place overall finisher was Jordon Hoffman with a personal record time of 46:26 for the 14k. First place female went to Rebecca Metzler with a gun time of 54:45 for the 14k. The course was shepherded by the bike crew organized by Dave Taylor. Radios essential for communication were provided by JPJ Electronics.

All runners were greeted at the finish line with enthusiastic volunteers passing out Catskill Spring water and 50th Anniversary finisher medals. You may have also seen Catskill Spring volunteering at a water station! The Kid's Kilometer runners were treated to chocolate milk provided by Cliff's Local Markets. Cups were donated by McDonald's. Thank you to Erik Winberg for being at the finish line and offering his expertise in physical therapy.

Runners took the short walk to the Doubletree Hotel for the after party with hospitality provided by Iconic. Runners entered the Crystal Ballroom to music and entertainment by Soundbarrier and enjoyed the spread of Bagel Grove bagels, Twin Orchards apples, Carlo Masi bananas, and sausage, eggs, potatoes, and coffee from Iconic.

The event ended with the awards ceremony. Thank you to Mickie Sanders-Jauquet and Don Lynskey and of course Rebecca LaPorte for assisting with the presentation. Awards recipients received commemorative 50th Anniversary pint glasses and the first place finisher received a Saranac six-pack beverage of their choice. In addition, Falling Leaves 14k was a RRCA Regional Championship event. Masters level winners received an additional medal from the RRCA presented by Mickie Sanders-Jauquet, the RRCA Eastern Region Director.


